SUBJECT: Waive Ordinance 220 Section 4 Prohibiting the Sale and Consumption of Alcohol in the Park During for the Heber Fall Fiesta on October 29, 2022.

ISSUE: Shall the Board waive Ordinance 220 Section 4 for the Heber Fall Fiesta on October 29, 2022.

GENERAL MANAGER RECOMMENDATION:

Waive Ordinance 220 Section 4 prohibiting the sale and consumption of alcohol in the park during the Heber Fall Fiesta on October 29, 2022.

FISCAL IMPACT:

DISCUSSION:

This year we are using the theme “Day of the Dead” and our fiesta will have free carnival games, great food & drinks, car show, craft vendors, alter, and haunted maze. We will be focusing on having more vendors with activities for kids and more food, drinks and items for sale. Our vendor forms are on line and Diahna Garcia-Ruiz from Proyecto Heber is handling the fiesta vendors and will secure the health permits. Proyecto Heber is also going to running the Beer Garden, which will require that the Heber Public Utility District waive Ordinance 220 to allow for the sale of alcohol in Tito park for this one day/night event.

HPUD has adopted Ordinance 220 that prohibits the sale and consumption of alcohol in Tito Huerta Park. In order for the Heber Fall Fiesta event to have alcohol sold and consumed, the HPUD Board must waive Ordinance 220 for a one-day event to be held on Saturday, October 29, 2022.

Proyecto Heber must complete all the necessary documents to secure a permit from the Bureau of Alcohol Beverage Control.

RECOMMENDATION:

It is recommended that HPUD Board waive Ordinance 220 to allow the sale of alcohol on October 29, 2022.

ALTERNATIVES:

- 1) Do not waive Ordinance 220 to allow to sale of alcohol at the Heber Fall Fiesta event.
- 2) Provide alternative direction from staff.
