Subject: May 2022 Monthly Report

On the billing cycle ending on the 22rd of May 28,036,000 gallons of water were used by our consumers, an average of 935,000 gallons was used per day.

On May 19, 2022, collected Trihalomethanes (TTHM's) samples and were sent to Clinical Lab of San Bernardino for analysis. The results came in on June 1, 2022 and were below the maximum contaminant levels (MCL) for TTHM's. The running annual average (RAA) MCL for TTHM's is 80 parts per billion (ppb) and we attained 60 ppb for the Mc Cabe site and 45 ppb for the Little Field site. Heber Public Utility District continues to be in compliance with the State and Federal Water Regulations.

The Rec Center will be closed on June 20th, 2022, in observance of Juneteenth.


For May, the Rec Center was used a total of 31 hours for reservations, this included a cardio class, SAL Polynesian Dance, and a Bible Study Group.
