Status:

APCD grant applications were approved in September 2021 and were approved by the California Air Resources Board (CARB) in October. The County Board of Supervisors approved all grants in their late March meeting. HPUD has six months to complete the projects.

HPUD and The Holt Group are currently working to get Pyramid Construction started on the Water Treatment Plant Paving Project that was awarded during the May 2022 regularly scheduled board meeting. The tree planting projects are scheduled to be completed mid to late fall.

Status:

During the April regularly scheduled BOD meeting, the HPUD Board of Directors awarded the contract to SLA Paving, to start paving at the Recreation Center. This project is expected to be completed by late summer of this year. The rest of the projects are currently being executed at the Recreation Center, such as the Heber Rec Center Equipment, we are waiting for orders to be fulfilled as there is still delays in shipping.

HPUD staff is currently in talks with the County of Imperial to be able to obtain eligibility to apply for the Community Block Grant Funds (CDBG). HPUD is currently exploring other options to obtain more funding for Children’s Park.

HPUD has been able to ask for the lowest bidder, Three Peaks Corporation to hold their bid until September in hopes that HPUD can locate other funding sources.
