SUBJECT: Heber Fall Fiesta Update

INFORMATION ONLY:

The 2022 Fall Fiesta has begun planning and staff is very excited for this years Fall Fiesta.



PARADE:

HPUD has obtained insurance for the Fall Fiesta. The Holt Group submitted the encroachment permit applications to the County of Imperial and CalTrans. We have received encroachment permits from the County and CalTrans.

The parade entry forms have been completed and we are once again waiving the fee for schools and youth organizations. We expect to have at least 40 entries. The parade route runs down Hawk from Heber Ave. to Oak Ave. Our Recreation Coordinator is currently sending out applications to schools for parade spots.

Sponsor and Advertising forms are completed and we will be sending them out via mail, personal contact and online this next few weeks.

The parade this year starts at 5pm. We will have multiple judges for the parade and multiple announcement stations as it is accustomed. Bleachers will be set up on Palm for Spectators.

FIESTA:

The theme for the Fall Fiesta has not changed, we are using the theme "Day of the Dead" and decorating like the movie Coco. We will be focusing on having more vendors with ample room with even more activities for kids. Our vendor forms are online at www.heberfallfiesta.com as well as in person at the District Office, Diahna Garcia-Ruiz from Proyecto Heber is handling the fiesta vendors and will secure health permits. Proyecto Heber will also be holding their annual Car Show during the fiesta. The Fall Fiesta will run from 4pm-11pm.

Currently Staff is meeting on a biweekly basis to start determining the other events at the Fall Fiesta such as the Maze, Altar de Muertos, Carnival Games, and live entertainment.
