#### Status:

APCD grant applications were approved in September 2021 and were approved by the California Air Resources Board (CARB) in October. The County Board of Supervisors approved all grants in their late March meeting. HPUD has six months to complete the projects.

The Holt Group has notified HPUD that there the Water Treatment Plant Paving Project can commence in late July.

The tree planting projects are scheduled to go out to bid in August and for the tree planting to begin after HPUD finds the lowest, responsible, and responsive bidder.

HPUD Staff will start processing for reimbursement next week. The Patio project will be going out to bid soon.

### Status:

HPUD staff is currently in talks with the County of Imperial to be able to obtain eligibility to apply for the Community Block Grant Funds (CDBG). HPUD is currently exploring other options to obtain more funding for Children's Park.

HPUD has sent the first reimbursement to the state to recover the non-construction costs for Children's Park. Non-construction costs are costs like design, bid management, and engineering.

HPUD has been able to ask for the lowest bidder, Three Peaks Corporation to hold their bid until September in hopes that HPUD can locate other funding sources.
