- E. UV System: Operating fine. Self-cleaning. February 28, 2022 and March 1, 2022 a Trojan technician and plant operators checked and serviced UV banks 1, 3, and 4. Replaced O-rings on the sleeves on all three banks. A hydraulic leak was detected and repaired by the wastewater plant operator.
- F. Vactor Truck: On March 7, 2022 and March 8, 2022 sewer lines on East Hawk, E. Pheasant, E. Mallard, and Valley st. were jetted and cleaned by H.P.U.D. Operators. The manholes on those alleys were also cleaned. On April 6, and April 7, 2022 CV Pipeline cleaned the sewer line on E. Correll St. up to the manhole on Rockwood Rd. On April 8, 2022 CV Pipeline also cleaned out the Regional Lift Station at the Wastewater Treatment Plant.
- G. TOTAL OF MILES OF SEWER LINES CLEANED OR VIDEOED: 1.5 miles.
- H. From February 21 through March 23, 2022: Heber Wastewater Plant received and treated 14.809 MG.
- I. HPUD did not exceed the daily maximum flow (1.2 MGD) as of March 23, 2022.

Subject: March 2022 Monthly Report

On the billing cycle ending on the 23rd of March 20,120,000 gallons of water were used by our consumers, an average of 670,000 gallons was used per day.

On March 17, 2022, collected Trihalomethanes (TTHM's) samples and were sent to Clinical Lab of San Bernardino for analysis. The results came in on March 30, 2022 and were below the maximum contaminant levels (MCL) for TTHM's. The running annual average (RAA) MCL for TTHM's is 80 parts per billion (ppb) and we attained 55 ppb for the Mc Cabe site and 42 ppb for the Little Field site. Heber Public Utility District continues to be in compliance with the State and Federal Water Regulations.



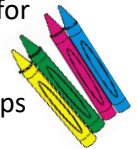
