# AB 617 Urban Greening and Paving Projects through the Imperial County Air Pollution Control District (APCD)

#### Status:

APCD grant applications were approved in September 2021 and were approved by the California Air Resources Board (CARB) in October. The County Board of Supervisors approved all grants in their late March meeting. HPUD has six months to complete the projects.

HPUD will solicit bids for the tree planting projects after the summer heat has passed to provide sufficient time for the trees to be established. HPUD submitted a Request for Proposals for the Water Treatment Plant Paving Project, which came in almost 43% higher than the engineer's probable cost. HPUD attended AB 617 committee meeting on April 6<sup>th</sup>, 2022, to request an increase of grant funding which was unanimously approved for an additional amount of \$29,374.00.

#### Status:

HPUD has been awarded 2 different Statewide Parks Grants, one for Children's Park and one for Correll Park. Children's Park officially submitted a Request for Proposals on April 7<sup>th</sup>, 2022. The bids that we received exceeded the Grant Amount. The low bid was Three Peaks Corp at \$1,565,899.00. HPUD is exploring options to find additional funding sources for Children's Park. Correll Park was just awarded with this grant in December 2021. HPUD has signed the grant contract with the State of California for Correll Park.
