SUBJECT: Modify the Reserve Resolution to Include the 25% Required Matching

Funds for AB 617 Grants.

ISSUE:

Shall the Board of Directors authorize a modification to the Reserve Resolution 2021-04 to include matching funds for AB 617 grants?

GENERAL MANAGER'S RECOMMENDATION:

It is recommended that the Board of Directors authorize a modification to the Reserve Resolution 2021-04 to include matching funds for AB 617 grants in the total amount of \$66,179.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Modification to the capital improvement Reserve Resolution must be made to complete these projects. Staff recommends modifying the Reserve Resolution to include additional expenditures as follows:

AB 617 Tree Planting Project - PARKS FUND	19,017
AB 617 Tree Planting and Asphalt Project - WATER FUND	34,162
AB 617 Tree Planting Project - SEWER FUND	12,999
TOTAL HPUD MATCH BY FUND WITH PAVING BID AMOUNT	66,179

PARKS FUND

According to the adopted Reserve Resolution 2021-04 the Parks Fund has a un-restricted reserve in the amount of \$462,387, which includes the purchase of a new truck that will not be expended this Fiscal Year due to supply chain issues. Approval would lower the unrestricted reserves to a balance of \$443,369.

WATER FUND

According to the adopted Reserve Resolution 2021-04, with the approved changes made on January 27, 2022 to include the repairs to Clarifier #1, the Water Fund has a un-restricted reserve in the amount of \$1,026,327. Approval would lower the un-restricted reserves to a balance of \$992,165.

SEWER FUND

According to the adopted Reserve Resolution 2021-04 the Sewer Fund has a un-restricted reserve in the amount of \$679,594. Approval would lower the un-restricted reserves to a balance of \$666,595.

DISCUSSION:

The AB 617 Urban Greening Grant Program requires at 25% match. When the Board authorized the submittal of the application, staff failed to request a budget modification to include the match requirement. This action will allow the District to continue to move forward with the six grants awarded through AB 617.

CONCLUSION:

As staff as identified that approval of the 25% match was not included in the report to the Board and a modification to our reserve budget was not made, it is recommended that the Board authorize a modification to the Reserve Resolution 2021-04 to include matching funds for AB 617 grants in the total amount of \$66,179.

ALTERNATIVES:

- 1) Do not authorize a modification to Reserve Resolution 2021-04 to include matching funds for AB 617 grants in the total amount of \$66,179. This will require the District to refuse the grants and terminate our previously executed Agreement.
- Approve some or the modifications, but reject the total. This will require that the District refuse some of the grants and terminate some previously executed Agreements.
- 3) Provide alternate direction to staff.
