

SUBJECT: Information Only Presentation on Correll Park

DISCUSSION:

The Heber Public Utility District (HPUD) reviewed plans for a new 15,000 sq. ft. park funded by a California State Parks grant, Prop 69. The retention basin at Heber Avenue and Correll Road, will include playground equipment, amenities, a regraded basin with drainage improvements, bio-retention, and basketball courts.

The Holt Group presented a conceptual site plan and hydrology study confirming basin capacity remains adequate. Plans also include ADA-accessible parking requiring a Right-of-Way Deed, bike lane re-striping, and new fencing. Permits for grading, building, and encroachment will be processed. County representatives accepted the preliminary design for permitting.

No other offer, discount, or special programs can be used with this grant program. This special matching fund offer applies to PowerScape®, PrimeTime®, Xscape®, and Modern City® systems only. Up to 50% matching funds for select outdoor fitness equipment, including THRIVE®, Challenge Course®, KidCourse®, and The Stadium®. Up to 50% matching funds are available for selected ECHO and TotStuff early childhood systems. VistaRope®, freestanding net structures, TuffForms, Landmark Design, GTSymphony freestanding, other freestanding play products, and Play On! non-system events are not eligible for funding. All applications must be received and validated by the project administrator by October 17, 2025. GameTime reserves the right to decline any application for a GameTime grant. 

AMERICAN SOCIETY FOR TESTING AND MATERIALS (ASTM)

Several key people at GameTime, including our Manager of Compliance and Standards, serve on the ASTM committee that sets the standards for the entire playground industry. GameTime products conform to that standard, ASTM F1487-07, the Standard Consumer Safety Performance Specification for Playground Equipment for Public Use.

CPSC

The Consumer Product Safety Commission is an independent agency within the United States Federal Government with the authority to inform the public of current product safety performance information and recommended practices. The CPSC first published their guidelines for public playgrounds in 1981 and have updated their publication since then. The current CPSC Handbook for Public Playground Safety, publication #325, is an excellent guide for owners and operators of public play environments.

IPEMA EQUIPMENT CERTIFICATION

GameTime is one of the founding members of IPEMA, and several of our people serve as board members, committee members and chairpersons of the association. In the interest of public playground safety, IPEMA provides a 3rd party certification, to validate conformance to established standards. Our use of the IPEMA seal is your assurance that GameTime has received written validation from an independent lab that the products associated with the seal conform with the ASTM standard, as well as the Canadian CSA standard CAN Z-614. IPEMA SURFACING CERTIFICATION

GameTime's GT Impax product provides you with the assurance that our surfacing has been certified as compliant to the appropriate ASTM standard. In the interest of public playground safety, IPEMA provides a third party certification to validate a manufacturer's conformance to the ASTM F-1292-99 Standard Specification for Impact Attenuation of Surface Systems Under And Around Playground Equipment. The use of the IPEMA Certification Seal displayed above signifies that the manufacturer has received written validation from the independent laboratory that the product associated with the use of the seal conforms with the requirements of ASTM F1292-99.
