Service Area Plan:

Plan preparation by THG was submitted to LAFCO for review by Executive Office on June 10th.

Development Updates:

Annexation: both the Westwind and Mc Cabe Ranch II project have agreed to fund an update of our Service Area Plan to move the annexation process forward with LAFCo.

Heberwood Estates is seeking a will serve letter to move forward with the project and is utilizing HPUD water while conducting earth work.

California Water Board:

HPUD Emergency Standby Basin Permit fee has been reassessed, upon GM request, from the previous \$21,150 to \$3,945 annually, saving the District \$17,205 per year.

Meter Project: Staff has almost complete meter installation project with only 300 meters left to be installed!
