

RESOLUTION NUMBER 2025-07

A RESOLUTION OF THE HEBER PUBLIC UTILITY DISTRICT MODIFYING THE ADMINISTRATIVE SERVICES FEE SCHEDULE TO ADJUST FEES FOR SERVICE CONNECTION, DISONNECTION, RECONNECTION DURING BUSINESS HOURS AND AFTER HOURS, LATE FEES, CREDIT CARD PROCESSING, AND PLAN CHECK REVIEW FEES.

WHEREAS, the Heber Public Utility District provides, maintains and operates a variety of programs and services to the public; and

WHEREAS, certain section of the Heber Public Utility District's policy authorizes the imposition and collection of fees to defray the costs of providing certain programs and services; and

WHEREAS, the Heber Public Utility District Board of Directors is charged with the responsibility of establishing Fees for Services that recover the cost of the District to provide those services; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors desires to modify the Administrative Service Fee Schedule to Establish and Modify Fees for Service Connection, Disconnection, Reconnection during business hours and after hours, Late Fees, Credit Card Processing, and Plan Check Review Fees; and

WHEREAS, it is the intention and desire of the Board of Directors to implement the modified Administrative Service Fee Schedule on January 1, 2023; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, DETERMINED AND ORDERED by the Board of Directors of Heber Public Utilities District as follows:

1. That the foregoing is true, correct and adopted.
2. Funds are needed to defray the cost of providing services furnished by the District.
3. The funds needed to defray and cover such operating expenses can and should be obtained by setting fees and charges for these services.
4. The setting of fees and charges for these services is exempt from compliance with the requirements of California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) and Proposition 218 "The Right to Vote on Taxes".
5. All other fee resolutions in effect and not amended herein, shall remain in full force.
6. Administrative Fee Schedule is attached as Attachment "A"

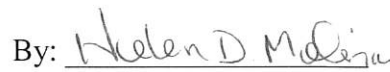

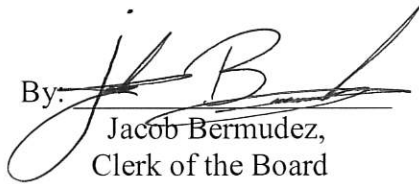

SUBJECT: Adopt Resolution 2025-07 to modify the Administrative Service Fee Schedule

ISSUE: Shall the Board Adopt Resolution 2025-07 to modify the Administrative Service Fee Schedule?

General Manager's Recommendation:

Adopt Resolution 2025-07 to modify the Administrative Service Fee Schedule to adjust fees for Service Connection, Disconnection, Reconnection during business hours.

FISCAL IMPACT:

None. The requested edits to the fee schedule align with historical practices of District Staff.

DISCUSSION:

At the December 15, 2022 Board of Directors meeting, a new Service Fee Schedule was adopted. The Administrative Service Fee Schedule adopted by Resolution 2022-23 listed both a Disconnection Fee and a Reconnection Fee of \$70 **each**. Historical practice at HPUD has been to only charge one fee.

Residents whose water is shut off are often in financial hardship and the addition of \$140 on top of their past due amount which is typically \$375 - \$575 would cause undue financial burden to the resident. Resolution 2025-07 aligns our Fee Schedule with District practice, charging one \$70 late fee for disconnection and reconnection.

Additionally, Resolution #2022-23 created an additional Late Fee for Trash Services of \$5.00. As the District does not charge water, wastewater and trash separately, the additional of a \$5.00 trash late fee created clerical confusion. It is recommended the \$5.00 trash late fee be removed to align with District current practice in which a general late fee of \$20 charged for any past due balance.

CONCLUSION:

Adopting Resolution 2025-07 aligns our Fee Schedule with District practice and protects residents from undue financial hardship.

Staff recommends Adopting Resolution 2025-07 to modify the Administrative Service Fee Schedule to consolidate fees for Service Connection, Disconnection fees and removing the trash late fee.

ALTERNATIVE:

- 1) Do not adopt Resolution 2025-07 and provide direction to staff
- 2) Adopt Resolution 2025-07 combining the \$20 general and \$5 trash late fees for a \$25.00 general late fee
