A RESOLUTION OF THE HEBER PUBLIC UTILITY DISTRICT TO PROVIDE A TEMPORARY EXTENSION OF WATER SERVICE TO DEPCOM POWER

WHEREAS, the Heber Public Utility District provides water, wastewater, solid waste, parks, and recreation services to the community of Heber; and

WHEREAS, Heber Public Utility District is seeking Imperial Local Agency Formation Commission (Imperial LAFCO) to extend Temporary Water Service to Depcom Power; and

WHEREAS, the extension of water service is outside the Heber Public Utility District service area; and

WHEREAS, Depcom Power will utilize the water for Civil Construction of a Solar Field in Holtville along Interstate 8; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the Heber Public Utility District to enter into an agreement with Depcom Power to provide a temporary water service.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE HEBER PUBLIC UTILITY DISTRICT, DOES HEREBY RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

1. That the foregoing is true, correct and adopted.
2. That the District shall provide the total amount of gallons used upon completion to Imperial County LAFCO

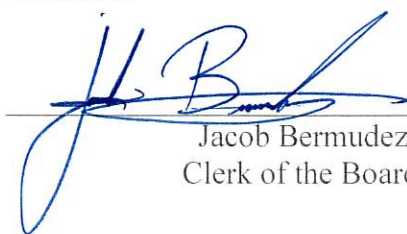

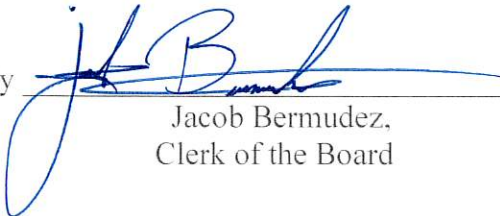
